

Want information should I put together to assist?

You should try and use this as a checklist:

1. How long have you and your partner been together? Confirm the date you began your relationship as well as the date of your marriage if you are married?
2. When did you and your partner separate? Confirm the date of separation.
3. Are there any children of the relationship (particular dependants)?
4. What assets do you own – you will need to list them and put an estimate of their value.
5. What debts do you have – you will need to list them and how much you owe.
6. If there are business assets – what are they? List them.
7. Financial statements for those business assets – the latest copy you have.
8. What is your current employment? Who do you work for and how much do you earn (net of tax) each week?
9. Do you receive any maintenance payments in lump sums or weekly from your former partner? List these.
10. If you own real estate – detail the address of each property. If you have the latest valuation bring that with you.
11. Name and address of your lawyer.
12. Have relationship property proceedings commenced – bring along the latest updated position of those matters.
13. Name and address of your accountant.
14. At any time did you sign a contracting out agreement or agreement where property was identified and treated as separate? If you did, bring a copy of that agreement along.
